Your Excellency:

Greetings in our Lord Jesus Christ!

Thank you so much for the \$15,000 help coming from the Cor Unum for the victims of Typhoon "Pepeng" (Parma - international name). I am sorry for this late acknowledgement because I misplaced the letter due to the many concerns of this office.

That typhoon Pepeng caused the death of 40 people, 5 missing, 5 injured. There are 285 barrios affected, 37,959 families affected, 151,779 persons evacuated in 54 evacuation centers. Many working animals perished. So many houses carried away; properties destroyed.

I am happy to report that the affected areas especially the six parishes most affected and our whole diocese responded with the best we could in the relief program. Now in the rehabilitation program: 60 houses were built, animal dispersal program is going on, livelihood program is promoted. The rehabilitation program continues.

We hope that our province and the whole country will enjoy sufficient rainfall but will not suffer the destruction again of super typhoons and floods.

Once again, thank you very much. God reward you and all the benefactors. Requesting you for your prayers and blessings for all of us in our diocese, I am,
