Education for Poor Children

— Nkaimurunya, Kenya —



In the Nkaimurunya community outside of Nairobi, Kenya, poor children are at a definite disadvantage. The low-income area offers little opportunity for employment and is known for high rates of malnutrition and HIV/AIDS. As a result, children in this area grow up in poverty and its accompanying social ills.

Father Fabian Hevi, a local priest with the Society of African Missions, knows that these children don't have to settle for a life of misery and struggle. That's why he's developed a plan to educate the children of Nkaimurunya through tuition scholarships to local Catholic primary and secondary schools. This is a cost-effective way to help the area's poorest children, ensuring that they receive practical knowledge and spiritual guidance.

Project Synopsis

Description

This project will provide scholarships for impoverished students to attend Catholic primary or secondary schools.

Purpose

To give the children of impoverished households a safe, nurturing and educational alternative to life in the streets.

Location

Nkaimurunya, a community outside Nairobi, Kenya, in the Diocese of Ngong.

Cost

\$24,000 will give 110 poor children scholarships to local Catholic schools. That's approximately \$188 per student!

Highlights

- In the Nkaimurunya community, outside of Nairobi, Kenya, many poor children and teens can't afford tuition to attend school.
- Fr. Fabian Hevi, a priest with the Society of African Missions (SMA), has ministered to the community for years and began a scholarship program as a cost-effective way to provide education to the neediest children in the community.
- Students in the program will receive scholarships to attend local Catholic schools. This school year, 98 scholarship recipients will attend primary school, and 12 will attend secondary school.
- To ensure students with the most need receive scholarships, regular home visits will take place. These visits will also ensure that each child is keeping up with his or her studies.
- Not only will these children receive a top-notch education, they will also receive Catholic spiritual formation at school, a key component to lasting transformation.
