Project Summary

Description

This project will help our mission partner — Association Cross Mozambique (ACM) — construct sturdy cement houses for families with vulnerable children, currently living in dilapidated shacks.

Purpose

To bring stability, dignity and the love of Christ to the oppressed and the orphaned by giving them a safe shelter to call their own.

Location

Ngolhoza, in the outskirts of Maputo, Mozambique's largest city. It is located near eSwatini and South Africa, in the southernmost part of the country.



Cost

\$17,338 is needed to help construct four **sturdy, concrete block homes**.

Highlights

- Mozambique's children have been hit hard by Africa's HIV/AIDS pandemic and a brutal civil war, which have left 700,000 orphans in their wake.
- Traditionally, these boys and girls have been taken in by neighbors or by extended family members; and in recent years, the sheer number of lives lost due to disease and war has caused tremendous overcrowding in the homes of these loving families.
- Each home that is built is a solid, concrete-block house with cement floor and a metal roof with a door that locks. ACM also builds latrines to address sanitation issues.
- ACM is an integral Catholic ministry that serves the needs of poor orphans and vulnerable children through nutrition, education, preventative health care and spiritual formation.
- Cross Catholic Outreach is ACM's only major funder, and is committed to providing support for the orphans and vulnerable children of Maputo — but we need your help!

Mozambique's Orphans

Since its independence from Portugal in 1975, Mozambique has been battered by civil war, famine and the social consequences of the HIV/AIDS pandemic, all of which have left a devastating number of children orphaned and living on the street. Traditionally, orphaned boys and girls are usually taken in by neighbors or by extended family members, but those caregivers have been overwhelmed by the sheer number of adult lives lost due to disease.

There are simply too many orphans and too few caregivers to provide relief. Fortunately, local Catholic leaders are working hard to address this crisis, and with your help, they can stand as a beacon of hope and service in this area of desperate need. One of these dedicated Catholic programs is Association Cross Mozambique, which is now building homes for the extended families of Mozambique's orphans and vulnerable children.

- An estimated **2.2 million** people are living with HIV/AIDS.
- An estimated **70,000** people die from AIDS each year.
- There are nearly **830,000** parentless children, and that number increases daily.
- **43%** of children are malnourished.
- **22%** of children have to work to help support their families.
- Only **47%** of people over the age of 15 can read and write.
- **46%** of the population falls under the poverty line.
- The average person has a life expectancy of **60** years.

The ACM Housing Ministry

From the time ACM first began ministering to some of the thousands of orphans and vulnerable children who live in the Maputo area, its goal has always been more than just keeping them in school and helping them to survive. Dedicated Catholics such as ACM's director, Doroteia Balane, know that these children — who range in age from 6 to 18 — are at an extremely vulnerable point in their lives.

To help these destitute children, Doroteia and ACM take a holistic approach. Not only do they meet each child's physical needs through food, education and preventative health care, they also meet their spiritual needs through Bible study, prayer and encouraging church attendance. In addition, they reach out to each child's extended family and try to address challenges with his or her living conditions.

Most of these families live in crude, makeshift dwellings in the middle of some of the worst slums in Maputo. They might own a single bed, but most of the family sleeps on the floor. A cramped, suffocating situation like this only becomes worse if the family takes in additional orphaned children. Providing better housing elevates the living conditions of everyone in the family!

ACM builds sturdy, cement-block homes with strong galvanized metal roofs for just **\$4,334** per home. When you support this outreach, you also encourage family participation. Everyone who receives a home is asked to help with its construction to the extent that they are able.

Working alongside a skilled construction crew, the family uses supplies purchased through donations from benefactors like you! Through this hands-on process, families gain a sense of dignity and ownership while learning there is a God who cares about their needs — both spiritual and physical.

These are simple houses, but they are an incredible answer to prayer for the poor families who have orphaned children to care for.



Housing Highlights



Safe, Secure Homes

Each house includes a solid foundation, a waterproof roof, cement-block walls, a living area that can be subdivided into bedrooms if the recipient wishes, a lockable door and windows.

Improved Sanitation

Each house includes a sanitary latrine. This is critical because proper sanitation facilities translate into healthier children and a dramatically improved quality of life.



A Solid Foundation

In situations where families own land, ACM will build the new house adjacent to the existing dwelling. Otherwise, ACM will relocate the family to a donated plot of land and build the house there.
