Executive Summary

Description

This project will send nutrient-rich Vitafood meals to feed hungry children, the sick and other vulnerable Hondurans through our local ministry partner, The Pearl Association. Vitafood is scientifically formulated with the optimal balance of vitamins, minerals, protein, fiber, fat and carbohydrates to meet the needs of malnourished children. The Pearl Association will distribute the meals throughout its local distribution network of 170 institutions, including hospitals, health centers, children's centers, schools, feeding centers and Catholic medical dispensaries.

Purpose

To fight hunger, rehabilitate the malnourished, strengthen medical programs in underserved communities, and live out Christ's call to serve the vulnerable.

Location

The Central American country of Honduras.

Cost

Our goal is to send 1,360,800 meals to Honduras at a cost of about **\$100,000**. Every dollar sends 14 donated meals!

Highlights

NEED

- 60% of Hondurans live in poverty.
- 23% of children are stunted, with peaks of up to 40%.
- Anemia affects 29% of children under 5 — with a prevalence of up to 60% in babies between 6 and 8 months.

A Country Beset by Tragedy

Since 1998, Honduras has lived in the shadow of Hurricane Mitch, a horrific storm that wiped out 70% of the country's crops and destroyed about 80% of the nation's transportation infrastructure. The destruction was so bad that Carlos Roberto Flores, the president at the time of the disaster, said Mitch had reversed 50 years of progress.

More than 30 years have passed since Mitch, but the havoc that hurricane and other disasters have wreaked on Honduras continues to ripple through the country. For example, the year 2020 saw back-to-back hurricanes Iota and Eta on top of a pandemic, and ongoing COVID-19 restrictions are also placing a heavy burden on families struggling to get by.

Kenia Maradiaga is a case in point. She sometimes goes days without eating because of a rise in food costs and a decline in work. She searched diligently for other odd jobs to increase her income, but still went to bed hungry more often than not.

Guillermina Perez has a similar story. She lives in Pacayal, a remote community where many families have lost jobs and opportunities because of the pandemic. Unable to access a variety of foods, Guillermina feeds her three children almost exclusively beans and plantains. She knows her family is undernourished, but she has no way to improve her humble means.

Thankfully, Kenia and Guillermina have not been forgotten by God or his Church. Through Cross Catholic Outreach's partnership with a local charity — The Pearl Association — these women and others like them have found both a source of food and a reason to hope. Guillermina says the Vitafood meals she is now receiving give her children the energy they need to thrive in school.

The Pearl Association is able to reach these needy families through its network of 170 hospitals, health centers, children's centers, schools, feeding centers, Catholic medical dispensaries and medical brigades. Their system is impressive, but it relies on major food shipments provided by Cross Catholic Outreach — and friends like you — to continue its critical services to the poor in Honduras.
